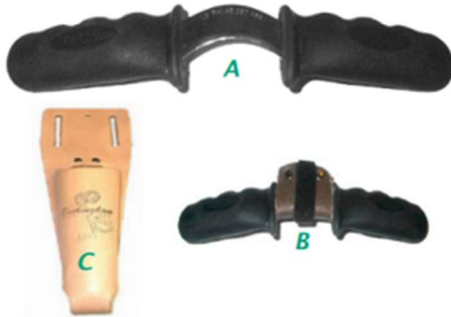

BuckSkinner™ Cable Stripping Device

Warning: Do not use this product if you cannot understand and follow the instructions and warnings that come with it and complete all necessary functions.

The Buckingham BuckSkinner™ is designed to quickly, safely, and effectively strip wire. The device is ergonomically designed, featuring a dual handle configuration with finger guards to help protect the users fingers. The blade edge has a convex shape to strip only the insulation jacket and not the conducting wire.

The BuckSkinner blade has a length of 2" and a width of 3/4", the handles are 4" each in length, and the total weight is only 0.35 lbs. The Blade Guard is a hook and loop guard made from impregnated nylon. The Holster is made from leather and weighs 4.48 oz. BuckSkinner handles are made of molded rubber and the blade is made from steel.

Three P's for Stripping Cable



Penetrate the blade into the insulation jacket of the cable at an approximate thirty degree angle from the cable.



Place thumbs under the cable and apply pressure with your thumbs to the bottom of the cable as the BuckSkinner cuts the jacket.



Pull with straightened arms once the sharpened edge is on the conductor. Lean back and ease the knife towards you to strip the insulation jacket.

Maintenance and Storage:

Keep the BuckSkinner blade dry and clean. Using lukewarm water with a dish soap provides the best and safest method of cleaning the blade without leaving any adverse effects on the blade. The blade must be rinsed in lukewarm water after cleaning, and then a clean dry cloth can be used to dry the blade. Do not store this product in a damp environment or with any corrosive chemicals. Sharpen in the same manner as you would any other knife edge.

Inspection and Retirement Criteria:

All BuckSkinner skinning knives must be inspected at time of purchase, before, during, and after each use. Inspections must ensure that the surface of the blade has no cracks, corrosion or excessive wear; and that the handle guards have no evidence of wear or cracks. If any evidence of wear or deterioration as outlined above is observed, or you have reasonable doubt about the condition of the product, immediately cease use, destroy the product, and replace it with new equipment. Should any unusual conditions not outlined above be observed, or you have reasonable doubt about a particular condition, remove the BuckSkinner from service and notify your Supervisor, Safety Director or contact Buckingham Mfg. for clarification. Failure to carefully and completely inspect your stripping knife could result in serious injury or death.

Proper Usage:

The BuckSkinner is intended for stripping overhead or underground cables of up to 2 inches in diameter. Do not position the knife so that the blade curves away from the cable. Ensure there are no obstructions along the knife's path prior to stripping the cable. When stripping a cable, only apply steady pressure to the blade. Do not jerk the knife back and forth, rapid changes in the users applied pressure may cause the knife to slip, which could lead to possible injury or death. The thirty-degree angle with the cable should be maintained when stripping the cable, too steep or shallow of an angle could lead to injury or death. If you are unsure of proper technique or application, seek proper training. If the suitability for intended use is in doubt, contact supplier, consult a safety engineer, or contact Buckingham Mfg. at 1-800-937-2825 before using.

Warnings:

- This equipment is intended for use by properly trained professionals only. Special training and knowledge are required to use this equipment.
- Please consult with your physician prior to using this product. Do not use this product under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
- Completely read, understand, and follow all markings, instructions, warnings, and guidelines pertaining to the use of Cable Stripping Knives and all associated equipment before use. Failure to do so could result in your serious injury or death.
- Use and inspect the equipment in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions and applicable OSHA regulations / guidelines.
- Wear all personal protective equipment including but not limited to cut resistant gloves and safety glasses when using the BuckSkinner.
- Store the BuckSkinner with guard attached or holstered when not in use. Buckingham suggests the use of the PN 70951 Blade Guard and the PN 4051 Holster for storage.
- Do not alter or modify a BuckSkinner in any way.
- Only Buckingham Mfg. Co. or those people authorized in writing by Buckingham Mfg. Co. may make repairs to this equipment.
- Avoid contact of these knives with high temperature surfaces, welding, or other heat sources, electrical hazards and corrosive chemicals which may damage the material.
- Use BuckSkinner stripping knives only for the specific purpose for which it is designed and intended.
- Buckingham equipment should not be resold or provided to others for re-use after use by original user as assurance cannot be granted that a used product meets criteria of applicable standards and is safe for use to a subsequent user.
- Do not use excessive force if the knife gets stuck while stripping the cable.

STATEMENT of OBSOLESCENCE:

Precise “useful life expectancy” or “shelf life” for this product is not specified, as the degree of use, conditions of use, and the degree of care and storage determines useful life. All users maintain responsibility to select proper equipment for the job, be properly trained in its use, and ensure all personnel support equipment passes inspection before each use. Upon evidence of defects, damage or deterioration, all equipment shall be removed from service immediately and tagged or marked as unusable or destroyed. This statement is made in conformance and compliance with BS EN 365:2004. International users must ensure that product inspections are completed by Competent Persons as defined by international standards including but not limited to British Standard (“BS”). If equipment fails any inspections, it must be immediately withdrawn from service and destroyed.
