FELLING BELT INSTRUCTIONS

PN 169071 Series

The Ergo Felling Belt was designed with ergonomic features that include added lumbar support, additional padding in the legs and hips, an abdominal stabilizer, and suspenders to support the belt and the load you are carrying. In addition to the ergonomic features, this felling belt also includes an array of storage options such as a chainsaw holder, axe storage, and pouches for gas or oil bottles. A drag handle is also incorporated into this product for situations that could require emergency removal; however, the drag handle is **NOT** to be used for fall protection under any circumstance. See Figure 1 and Figure 2 for additional features of this product.

Selection of products should be such that they aid the worker in the performance of his job and particular work situation. Therefore, be certain this equipment is suitable for the intended use and work environment. The Ergo Felling Belt must only be used as an aid to stow and transport accessories / tools. The Ergo Felling Belt **MUST NOT** be used as personal protection equipment for positioning, support or fall arrest. This belt is designed to support only the weight of the accessories / tools it contains, **NOT** the weight of an individual. Proper personal protection equipment must be used according to the type of work being completed. Do not alter this product in any way. Only Buckingham Mfg. Co. or those people authorized in writing by Buckingham Mfg. Co. may make repairs to this equipment. If a belt strap does not fit properly, replace it with one of the correct size. Wear belt snug but not tight.

Sizing:

Typical sizing:

<u>Waist Size</u>	<u>Belt Size</u>
24-28"	X-Small
28-32"	Small
32-36"	Medium
36-40"	Large
40-44"	X-Large

Donning Felling Belt:

- ensure there are no twisted straps,
- put arms through shoulder straps,
- clip the chest buckle together,
- attach the abdominal stabilizer hook and loop together,
- feed belt strap through tongue buckle and connect.

Adjustment:

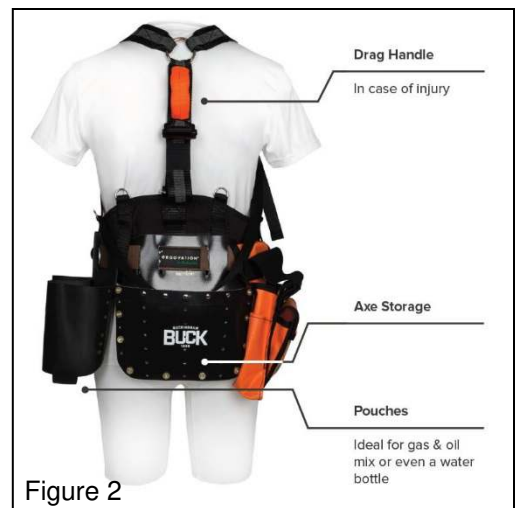
- This belt should be adjusted such that it assists with the weight distribution of the accessories / tools it contains and to maintain the correct position on your body. This is done by loosening, or tightening, the strap(s) end through the buckles on the shoulder straps and belt strap through the tongue buckle.

Cleaning:

Proper maintenance and storage of your equipment will prolong its useful life and contribute toward its performance. The equipment should be cleaned and maintained at regular intervals depending on usage.

Nylon - Clean with water and mild soap (a dish washing soap that removes grease (i.e. Dawn)) and allow to dry thoroughly without using excessive heat. Do not use any type of corrosive substance or acid, which will gradually eat away the fabric.

NOTE: Ensure proper fit / size of product before use. This product cannot be returned unless it is in new / unused condition.
