Warning: Do not use this product if you cannot understand and follow the instructions and warnings that come with it and complete all necessary functions.

Buckingham's PN 6251 Suspenders are designed to support the weight of the body belt and the tools attached to it. These suspenders also aid in keeping the user's body in the belt in an event where the user has been inverted. The individual's weight must be supported by a properly sized Linemen's Body Belt with the belt buckle properly engaged. Never detach the waist belt buckle of a body belt when it is in use.

Wearing the body belt too low and using the combination as a saddle is an IMPROPER USE of the products.

Suspenders ARE NOT to be used as Fall Protection Equipment as there are no rated fall arrest attachment points.

Suspenders are one size fits all.

<u>6Installation:</u>

- To attach the PN 6251 suspenders to a body belt, disconnect the ends of the suspender back straps by unweaving them from the plastic friction buckle and 2 slot buckle. Place the suspender back straps in the opening between the body belt back pad and the body belt waist strap and form a loop around the body belt waist strap (Fig. 1 - 4). Next, feed it back through the 2 slot buckle and then through the plastic friction buckle (Fig. 5). Repeat this process for the opposite side suspender back strap (Fig. 6).
- To attach the front straps, first feed the billet end of the waist strap through the loop of the corresponding suspender front strap (Fig. 7). Next, feed the buckle end of the waist strap through the loop on the opposite side strap (Fig. 8). Buckle the waist strap and visually check attachments prior to use. Fig. 5

Adjustment:

Suspenders should be adjusted such that they assist with the weight distribution of the body belt and to maintain it in the correct position. This is accomplished by loosening, or tightening, the strap end adjusting the web through the 2 slot buckles on the front of the suspenders. After adjusting, placement should reflect that of Fig. 9 & 10.

Cleaning: Fig. 6

Proper maintenance and storage of your equipment will prolong its useful life and contribute toward its performance. The equipment should be cleaned and maintained at regular intervals depending on usage.

Clean with water and mild soap (a dish washing soap that removes grease (i.e. Dawn)) and allow to dry thoroughly without using excessive heat. Do not use any type of corrosive substance or acid, which will gradually eat away the fabric. Fia. 7
